



The CF 98, also known as NP 42, is the most recent development of the Chinese state arms factories, and, apparently, it is now adopted by the PLA (Chinese people's Liberation Army) forces.

QSZ-92 (Chinese Nomenclature) pistol is available in two versions, with the only difference being caliber: one is chambered for most common 9x19mm Luger / Parabellum ammunition (QSZ-92-9), and another is chambered for proprietary 5.8mm ammunition with bottle-necked case and pointed bullets (QSZ-92-5.8).

The development of the QSZ-92 pistol apparently began in 1994, and it is in limited service with PLA since the late 1990s.
